

Older Elementary Spring – 1 Corinthians to Philemon – Year 2

1. 1 Corinthians 12:27-28 – “Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. And God has appointed in the church first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, helping, administrating, and various kinds of tongues.”
2. 1 Corinthians 12:29-30 (review 27-28) - “Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? Do all possess gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?”
3. 1 Corinthians 12:31 (review 27-30) – “But earnestly desire the higher gifts. And I will show you a still more excellent way.”
4. 1 Corinthians 13:1 (review 12:27-31) – “If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.”
5. 1 Corinthians 13:2-3 (review 12:27-13:1) – “And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.”
6. 1 Corinthians 13:4-5 (review 12:27-13:3) – “Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful.”
7. 1 Corinthians 13:6-7 (review 12:27-13:5) – “It does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, endures all things.”
8. 1 Corinthians 13:8 (review 12:27-13:7) – “Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away.”
9. 1 Corinthians 13:9-10 (review 12:27-13:8) – “For we know in part, and we prophesy in part, but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away.”
10. 1 Corinthians 13:11 (review 12:27-13:10) – “When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways.”
11. 1 Corinthians 13:12 (review 12:27-13:11) – “For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.”
12. 1 Corinthians 13:13 (review 12:27-13:12) – “So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.”
