

1. Matthew 22: 37-39 –“And he said to him, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’”
2. Exodus 20: 3 –“You shall have no other gods before me.”
3. Exodus 20: 4 –“You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.”
4. Exodus 20: 7 –“You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.”
5. Exodus 20: 8 –“Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.”
6. Exodus 20:12 –“Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.”
7. Exodus 20: 13 –“You shall not murder.”
8. Exodus 20:14 –“You shall not commit adultery.”
9. Exodus 20: 15 –“You shall not steal.”
10. Exodus 20: 16 –“You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.”
11. Exodus 20: 17 –“You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor's.”
12. II Corinthians 5:21 –“For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.”
13. Review week (Matthew 22: 37-39; Exodus 20:3, 4, 7, 8, 12 – 17; II Corinthians 5:21)

Note to the teacher: The students are memorizing several longer passages throughout this quarter. It is expected that when you are working on a new passage that is continuing from an earlier memorized portion that you would review the entire passage with the class. When they review all the verses at the end, it is expected that they would say these passages altogether, not in chronological order.
