

Middle Elementary Winter – God’s Design for Worship Year 2

1. Exodus 24:3 –“Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD and all the rules. And all the people answered with one voice and said, “All the words that the LORD has spoken we will do.”
2. John 1:14 –“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”
3. Exodus 25:8-9 –“And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell in their midst. Exactly as I show you concerning the pattern of the tabernacle, and of all its furniture, so you shall make it.”
4. Hebrews 10:5-6 –“Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, “Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me; in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.”
5. Exodus 29:45-46 –“I will dwell among the people of Israel and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, who brought them out of the land of Egypt that I might dwell among them. I am the LORD their God.”
6. Hebrews 10:7-8 –“Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come to do your will, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book.’” When he said above, “You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings” (these are offered according to the law),” [Review Hebrews 10:5-6.]
7. Leviticus 11:44a –“For I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy.”
8. Hebrews 10: 9-10 –“then he added, “Behold, I have come to do your will.” He does away with the first in order to establish the second. And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.” [Review Hebrews 10:5-8]
9. Hebrews 10: 11-12 –“And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God,” [Review Hebrews 10:5-10]
10. Hebrews 10: 13-14 –“waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.” [Review Hebrews 10:5-12]
11. Hebrews 7:24-25 –“but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever. Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.”

12. Hebrews 10:24-25 –“And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.”

13. Review Week

Note to teacher:

The students are memorizing a large passage Hebrews 10: 5-14 because it specifically talks about Christ being our High Priest. When these verses come up in the weekly assignment be sure to review what has already been memorized with the students in addition to helping them learn the new section. When they review all the verses at the end, it is expected that they would say this passage altogether, not in chronological order from how it was memorized.
